1. **Exhibits will be received in the Industrial Tent from 12.30 p.m. until 2.00 p.m. on Friday, 21st July.** All exhibits must be placed on their respective numbers by 2.00 p.m. on **Friday, 21st July**, and must remain there until 4.30 p.m. on **Saturday, 22nd July**.
2. **Judging will start at 2.30 p.m. on Friday, 21st July.** The judges' decisions are final.
3. The Industrial Tent will be open to the public on **Friday, 21st July** from **6.30 p.m.** until 9.00 p.m. and on **Saturday, 22nd July**, from 10.00 a.m. until 4.00 p.m. The tent will be completely closed at 4.00 p.m. Exhibits to be collected at 4.30 p.m.
4. The Club shall not be liable for loss or damage from accident or otherwise. Every precaution will be taken to protect Exhibits.
5. List of Baking and Articles intended to be exhibited should be lodged, on the Schedule provided for the purpose, with the Secretary, preferably by **Monday, 10th July**.
6. A Points Prize will be awarded to the Exhibitor gaining most points in each Section (i.e. four separate points prizes). 1st Prize to count 3 points, 2nd Prize 2 points and 3rd Prize 1 point. In the event of a tie, most 1st Prizes count.
